

ORDINANCE NO. 10

CURFEW ORDINANCE

Section 1.

No person under the age of 18 years shall loiter, idle, wander, or play on foot or in a vehicle upon the street, alleys, highways, roads, sidewalk, parks, playgrounds, public grounds, in public buildings, or buildings open to the public for recreation or business purposes, on vacant lots, or other unsupervised places in the Township between 10:30 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., Sunday evenings through Friday mornings and between 12:00 midnight and 5:00 a.m. Friday evenings through Sunday morning, unless accompanied by a parent, guardian, or other adult with delegated authority; provided this Section shall not apply to such person while returning home from functions authorized by any public or parochial school or church while such return is being made by the shortest and most direct route and as soon as possible under the circumstances. This Section shall not apply to children returning home from place of employment provided any such person shall be returning home by the shortest and most direct route and as soon as possible under the circumstances.

Section 2.

Anyone violating the terms of this Ordinance shall forfeit not less than Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars nor more than Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars, together with the costs of prosecution thereof, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs of prosecution shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until such forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding ten (10) days.
